### **Student funded places scheme**

#### **Two free student places are available to postgraduate students**

The places will fund delegate fees only

Student free/subsidised fee applications must be submitted by the **26th February 2010**.

All successful applicants must present their student identity card when registering at the conference venue.

Priority for the free places will be given to applicants who are currently not receiving financial assistance e.g. studentships, other bursaries. The subsidised fee places will be issued after the fully subsidised applicants have been selected.

### **Budget accommodation in Manchester**

#### **The Hatters Hostel**

A large hostel offering dormitory style accommodation from £15 per person per night. Private rooms are from £27 per person per night. Prices include a light continental style breakfast and shared bathroom facilities.

The Hatters hostel and its sister hostel, the Hilton chambers, are located in the Northern Quarter of Manchester. The hostels are a 5 minute walk from Manchester Piccadilly Train station, and a 20minute walk to the conference venue.

#### **YHA Manchester**

A large canal-side hostel located in Potato Wharf, Castlefield. The hostel has a very limited number of 2 person rooms, the majority accommodate 4. Prices start from £18 per person per night. The hostel has kitchen and restaurant facilities.
